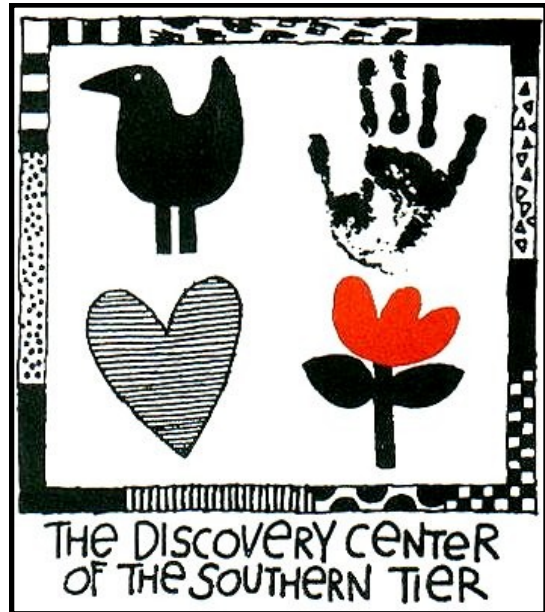


# Daisy Girl Scout Workshops Spring 2010
